## Rules of entry

Entries can come from schools, youth groups and organisations working with children and young people aged 18 and under - as well as individuals.

Entrants can receive help from adults, but the nature of this help must be stated. There is no set theme and entries can be documentaries, fiction, animation.

Maximum length will be 10 minutes.

Films will be selected by a panel consisting of BBC Voices producers and all films must recognise that they are being shown in a public place and viewed by people of all ages. They must, therefore, meet The Forum's Fusion quidelines (copy available on request).

Entries should be submitted on mini DV tape, or high quality video data file (e.g. AVI, MOV). The film must be the children or young person's own original material and you must have the authority to submit your film and have checked with any other contributors before doing so.

Please do not send in your only copy as we will not be able to return submissions.
