

Administering the

Phonics Screening Check

9th May 2012, 4.30-6.00pm Norwich Professional Development Centre

This June will see the implementation of the new statutory phonics screening check for all Year 1 children.

Teachers are required to administer the check as the role demands professional judgement about whether or not children's responses are correct.

Feedback from the pilot suggested that **training on the scoring rules is essential** for teachers administering the check to score consistently. Consequently, the STA encourages schools to hold training sessions for those involved in administering the check to ensure they are all fully prepared.

This course provides schools with this opportunity.

Using official materials related to the phonics screening check, this course aims to support teachers to **make sense of** the Access and Reporting Arrangements (ARA) and other guidance to **ensure that** all statutory requirements are met. In particular it will **focus on** supporting those administering the check to **interpret** children's responses so that teachers **feel confident** they can score the check accurately, leading to an accurate data set.
