As you are aware Norfolk's High Quality PE Chartermark Award is designed to ensure a high quality experience and entitlement for all young people in Norfolk. To date, 53 schools in Norfolk have achieved this prestigious award and the concept is now being replicated in other parts of the country.

Derreck Murphy, Leader of Norfolk County Council, has challenged all Norfolk Schools who have not yet applied to do so in 2012 – the Olympic Year. This would reflect the legacy that Lord Sebastian Coe, the former Olympic 1,500 metre gold medallist and 800 metre silver medallist, spoke so passionately about during his speech for the London bid to host the 2012 Summer Olympics in Singapore four years ago.

Headteachers should be reassured that there is very little additional work involved as the process is all about the documentation that should already be in place for Ofsted, and which was supported through the National School Sports Partnership Programme. The process has also been combined with the PE Subject Leadership Award (Primary) to ensure another level of support to schools.

The next round of applications for the Chartermark Award closes on Tuesday 31st July 2012 with all submissions required to be with us by 5:00pm.
