Training for new Educational Visits Co-ordinators

It is a legal requirement for all schools to have appointed an Educational Visits Co-ordinator (EVC), which should be a senior member of staff, or the role needs to be undertaken as part of a team that includes senior staff. One of the tasks of an EVC is to assess the competency of visit leaders.

Following this course you will:

- Understand the roles and responsibility of the Local Authority in relation to enabling Educational Visits.
- Understand the role of the EVC within the school environment.
- Know how to access support, having received practical advice and high quality training.
- Be able to follow the Local Authority's approval process.
- Have an increased awareness of planning and risk management.
- Have an introduction to EVOLVE, the Internet Based Notification/Approval system.
