



## Artsmark Training Dates

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The Norfolk & Norwich Festival have organised a string of free Artsmark training sessions over the summer in six areas of East Anglia with the aim of **providing valuable information to schools and colleges that want to find out more before they apply and to assist those that have definitely decided to apply for Artsmark.**

The sessions are two hours long - There will be a will be **an introduction on the Festival's role as a Bridge Organisation and what it means for this region.** The majority of the session will be **a chance to get some up-to-date information about Artsmark and the benefits for your organisation and ofsted recognition.** The session will take you through the key areas of Artsmark and Artsmark Gold and there will be some practical advice on filling in the Artsmark application form. There will also be a brief overview of Arts Award.
