We will also explore the principles of permaculture to help ensure schools undertake sustainable grounds development that minimise the use of energy and water resources.

Lunch will be provided and the day will be led by Nell Seal (Advisor Sustainable Schools), Sue Falch-Lovesey (Head of Environmental and Outdoor Learning) and David Yates (County Landscape Architect).

This course will help delegates:

- identify ways of consulting with children and young people about school grounds developments
- understand the potential that exists for grounds developments by taking inspiration from real world examples
- consider the appropriate location of features within school grounds
- take a sustainable approach to grounds developments
- access information about available grants
