Risk Management of Trees for Outdoor Learning & Site Management (Level 1 inspection course)



Audience: Those using their grounds for learning, those responsible for maintaining school grounds/wooded spaces, Forest School Leaders, Caretakers and Site Managers

Context: A one-day certified course for those utilising their own or other wooded areas for outdoor learning and/or for those responsible for maintaining school grounds. This links well with 'Forest Schools'. The day will be led by Dave Dowson from Tree Life and lunch will be provided.

This assessed and certificated course helps delegates:

- identify obvious tree defects by visual inspection from ground level with the aid of binoculars, mallet and a probe
- record tree defects and place the tree in a broad category of risk rating
- identify the required action upon finding a tree with an obvious defect
