#### • American Trail

As part of our *Vintage Summer @ The Garage* season and the Norfolk American Trail project (co-ordinated by Norfolk Libraries and the Norfolk Museums Service) 20 young people will have the chance to partake in a FREE seven day film workshop. Not only will they be involved in the writing of the script, they will also have the chance to perform in the film if they wish as well as helping to put together the final edit of the film.

The project will look at the historical links between Norfolk and North America and be loosely based on local people's memories from the Second World War. This is an opportunity for young people to participate and engage in an aspect of Norfolk's history as well as hopefully gaining a greater understanding of local history and international connections.

The film will be premiered at The Garage as part of the Vintage Summer 2012 performance showcase in late August and will also feature on the BBC Big Screen outside Chapelfield Mall.

We are currently recruiting for 20 young people aged 14-20yrs, including 2 peer mentors who will ideally have some filmmaking experience.

# ONGOING...

• Big Breaks

This is a funding scheme designed to support young people from disadvantaged circumstances to take part in a full year of our regular, weekly activities - our creative classes. You can nominate young people for a place using our Referral Form. There are no set criteria & awards are offered at our discretion.

For places starting in Autumn 2012, we are encouraging referrals for senior streetdance and breakdance companies and particularly for ages 12-25yrs due to new funding. For dance referrals we can also offer some travel assistance if necessary.

Classes are open for public booking from 30<sup>th</sup> July so the first deadline for receipt of referrals is Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July. As the Autumn term starts on October 1<sup>st,</sup> late referrals will be considered until 21<sup>st</sup> September subject to availability. Referrals which cannot be accommodated this term will be kept on file for consideration for the Spring 2013 term.
