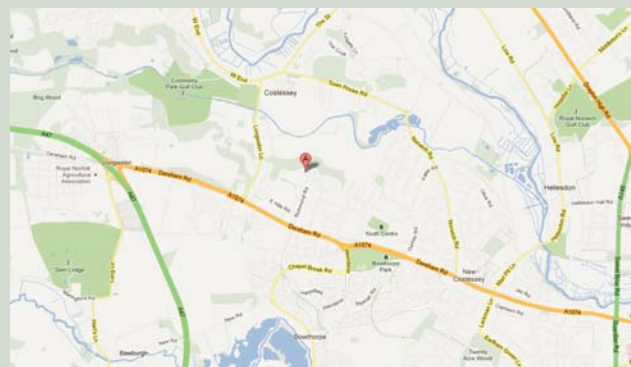

While doing research for a school assignment Felix came across the story of Wangari Maathai, a nobel prize Laureate who had planted more than 30 million trees in 30 years. At the end of his presentation, Felix envisioned a future in which children could plant a million trees in each country of the world.

Children from more than 100 countries around the world have already joined Plant-for-the-Planet: Our goal is to have empowered one million children as Climate Justice Ambassadors in over 20,000 Academies worldwide by 2020.
