Developing and Enhancing Your Skills as an NQT Induction Tutor

Course Context/Audience:

This course is aimed at NQT Induction Tutors in Primary and Secondary phase schools and other settings. Induction tutors play a key role and have significant responsibilities in the statutory induction arrangements. With key changes to induction scheduled for September 2012, this course will be suitable for new tutors and also for those staff who would like an opportunity to revisit key features of high quality induction programmes. Emphasis will be placed on the practical issues of planning and evaluating individualised programmes, writing quality assessment reports linked to the new Teacher Standards, action planning and handling 'difficult' issues and conversations when problems emerge. The course will involve attendance at three sessions :

- An initial training day in the Autumn term
- An afternoon session in the Spring term
- A final afternoon session in the Summer term

Objectives:

- explore the key roles and responsibilities of all those involved in statutory induction
- discuss features of high quality induction programmes and to investigate exemplars of effective induction documentation
- develop skills in setting objectives and agreeing action plans to support progression of NQTs across the induction year
- practice and reflect upon the writing of quality assessment reports linked to the new Teacher Standards
- discuss common issues and problems and to share effective approaches towards these
- provide a forum for networking and the sharing of good practice
