

Health and safety e-learning for schools

Health and safety e-learning modules are NOW available on Schools PeopleNet. There are 8 modules:

- *Introduction to Health & Safety*
- *Fire prevention and procedures*
- *Manual handling*
- *Display screen equipment*
- *Risk assessment*
- *Personal Safety*
- *Hazardous substances*
- *Slips and trips*

This suite of courses is designed to provide the user with a basic understanding of the various issues surrounding Health & Safety at Norfolk County Council. They cover the responsibilities of NCC as the employer and the employees, highlighting the key issues relating to each topic.

The modules are interactive and test the user's knowledge as they move through the course. They can be repeated as many times as the user wishes and ideal for refreshing knowledge. The completion of a course is determined by achieving 80% or more in the quiz, however there is no required standard. The main purpose of a score is to provide feedback to the learner and look back over the relevant content.

Who is it for?

All staff, the e-learning modules provides an introduction to the subject, once completed it will assist the user to make the decision whether further training is required. Some of the modules may not be so relevant to a user's role however it is advised the Introduction to Health and Safety and Fire prevention and procedures are completed by all staff.
