As from 1st October 2012 Ormiston Children & Families Trust in partnership with Mancroft Advice project (MAP), and Norfolk and Suffolk Foundation Trust (NSFT) will take over responsibility for delivering the targeted(Tier2) Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS) across Norfolk. This new service will be known as 'the HALO' and will support children and young people 0-18yrs of age.
