

Spooky Tales in Norwich Cathedral Quarter's Great Hospital

This Halloween Norwich Cathedral Quarter is holding a Spooky Story-telling event at The Great Hospital, Bishopgate. This FREE family event takes place between 4 and 6pm on Saturday 27th October. There will be story-telling by 'The Word Wizard' at 4.30pm for young children (7yrs and under) and another at 5.30pm for older children (8yrs+). There will also be a Halloween craft corner for children and refreshments available. Children (and adults) are encouraged to dress up for the occasion and there will be a prize for the 'best Halloween costume'. Some puppets from Norwich Puppet Theatre will be on display and there will be the opportunity for tours of the impressive Eagle Ward.

Families are encouraged to make a day of it and explore this beautiful area of our fine city. At 2.30pm there will be 'Luminous Tales' at Norwich Puppet Theatre, a puppet show about an old lady who tells stories of a time when there was no light and of a little girl who wanted to play with the moon. Tickets start from £3.50.

Following the story-telling event The Maids Head Hotel will be holding a Spooky Halloween Children's Party from 6-10pm which will include a disco, bouncy castle, spooky games and a fancy dress competition. The cost to attend is £6 per child which includes a spooky buffet and soft drink.
