Course Context/Audience:

This course is for Designated Professionals for safeguarding in schools or new Headteachers who have never received any previous safeguarding or child protection training.

Their role may involve making referrals to Children's Services, representing the school at a Child Protection Conference or contributing to an initial or core assessment. The course will enable staff to develop an awareness and understanding of child protection processes and issues.

Objectives:

- Understand what safeguarding is and the different ways in which children can be harmed, including indicators of abuse

- Describe the legal framework and guidance that underpins the child protection process
- Describe their own agency's child protection policies and procedures
- Describe the child protection process that follows a referral to Children's Services
- Know how to record concerns in accordance with agency guidelines, including communicating with parents/carers
