Big Breaks

This is a funding scheme designed to support young people from disadvantaged circumstances to take part in a full year of our regular, weekly activities - our creative classes. You can nominate young people for a place using our Referral Form. There are no set criteria & awards are offered at our discretion.

For Spring 2013, we are able to expand this offer to include a wider range of dance classes which include some ballet and contemporary classes and a number of beginner level adult classes. Please note that Big Break awards can only be awarded to people aged under 25yrs.

Classes are open for public booking from 17th Dec so the first deadline for receipt of referrals is Thursday 13th Dec. As the term starts on January 14^{th,} late referrals will be considered until 3rd January subject to availability. Referrals which cannot be accommodated this term will be kept on file for consideration for the Summer term.
