Excellence Leads to Change: sharing good practice in SEND cluster developments

This course aimed at: Headteachers, SENCOs, Governors and other staff with an interest in, and commitment to, developing effective cluster partnerships for SEND.

This one-day conference will present case examples of SEND cluster development in Norfolk. Volunteer cluster hosts will share their response to the change in distribution of SEND funding and identify an aspect of their collaboration which has enhanced their working. In addition, a cluster SENCO and Headteacher from Newark will offer a key-note presentation, sharing their experience of this way of working for children and families.
