## Digital Photography - One Day Workshop with Julia Rafferty

Spend the day photographing in the beautiful grounds of Holt Hall in North Norfolk and learn how to get the most out of your digital camera.

The day will include a number of photographic sessions exploring the grounds and getting to know the settings on your digital camera so that you will be able to take better photographs. The last session of the day will be an introduction and demonstration of the Adobe Photoshop software showing you how to edit your photos for presentation.

The camera sessions will include:

- getting out of Auto and using the more creative settings on your camera
- choosing the right White Balance setting to get great colours in your images
- getting the exposure right using Exposure Variation
- composition the key considerations
- angle of view where to stand, which lens to use (if you have a choice), zoom-in or zoom-out, low view or high view
- using a tripod for better composition and sharper photos

Photoshop demonstration will include:

- setting the correct resolution
- getting the exposure right and colours right
- using Filters to enhance your images
- saving and looking at file formats
- preparing to print

You will need to bring your digital camera with batteries fully charged and an empty memory card. Bring your camera manual if you can find it! Also a tripod if you have one. You will need to bring a packed lunch but tea, coffee and biscuits will be provided.
