

Would you like to access innovative exciting arts provision for the next 3 years?

The Garage is seeking expressions of interest from secondary schools who would like to be included in our 2nd stage application to the 'Start' programme.

Start is a grant-giving programme established by The Prince's Foundation for Children & the Arts to enable schoolchildren to experience the very best of the arts by introducing them to their local cultural venue.

The Garage's vision is to create a performing arts centre for, by and with young people, an accessible place where young people can be **inspired**, **trained** and **empowered** through participation, skills development and their experience of the arts.

What we can offer...

Following a successful 1st stage application, we now need to identify **3 schools** to work with us for the next **3 years**, with year 1 activities being:

- <u>2 visits</u> to see professional performances at The Garage through the 'Curtain Up!' programme which includes drama, music and dance, targeted to teenage audiences. Example companies include: Half Moon, Box Clever, 20 Stories High, Thick Skin, Fifth Word, Gomito, Hightide, Paines Plough etc.
- 2 in-school workshops with artists to support visits to The Garage
- <u>In-school workshops and session plans to develop the critical thinking skills</u> of the pupils, thus enabling them to plan their activities for years 2 and 3
- 4 teacher support sessions to support teacher CPD and project delivery
- Opportunity for teachers to attend networks (i.e. referral network and drama teachers network) to support progression opportunities for young people

Commitment from schools....

We are looking to work with schools that can:

- Nominate a contact person that we can work with to determine details of the project delivery
- Demonstrate a real ambition to improve arts provision in the school on a long term basis
- Contribute a small amount of funding to the project (this can be in-kind e.g. providing transport to and from the venue)

Eligibility...

At this stage, we are inviting expressions of interest from **secondary schools** within **30 minutes drive time of Norwich City Centre**, who do not have an existing relationship with a cultural venue and have **limited arts provision in school**.

In addition, the school should be able to demonstrate at least <u>one</u> of the following indicators of 'need':

- 1. Be situated in (or have a large intake from) an area of high levels of economic deprivation
- 2. Have a high percentage of children eligible for free school meals
- 3. Have limited access to other communities or cultural activity due to a rural location
- 4. Hold a most recent OFSTED rating of satisfactory or lower.
