Moving Day!

If you are lucky enough to be moving your school library - perhaps for a wonderful refurbishment, here are a few hints and tips.

- Once the planning for new shelving has been completed (SLS can help with this!) the next job is to weed and audit your stock. There's no point packing and moving tatty old books that your children don't want to read.
- To calculate how many boxes you need do a rough count of books, or look at your Junior Librarian, and average 30 books a box. More than that and boxes will be too heavy, or packed in a way that makes unpacking difficult. Seal and label boxes clearly (side & top) and stack close to where you will unpack so that you can unpack logically.
- Unpacking is usually quicker, but plan how your stock will run round the shelves, left to right, usually down the bays.
- Talk to us at SLS; we can provide peoplepower
- Plan enough time for all this; it will probably take longer than you think!

Fiction Discussion Groups


Get ready for a rich diet of Literature and storytelling this summer with this fab event.


Books we love this month!
