New Teachers Course

In response to the new funding and demand - teachers can now access a fully accredited course that will take them through all the areas of activity, inclusion and differentiation, health and safety, assessment, planning and Ofsted. This new course **Norfolk High Quality PE Teaching Award** is for teachers and aims to ensure that candidates are able to teach "Good" to "Outstanding" lessons in PE across the areas of activity. We have two courses planned, one in the West and one Norwich based. Schools can use their new funding to finance the course and provide cover for staff attendance on the 7 module (7 days) programme spread across the academic year.



Accountability

Our courses will provide schools with the evidence of compliance as required and inspected by Ofsted. They will ensure that staff are more confident and competent to teach PE, improving the **quality of teaching and learning**, **pupil achievement** and **quality of overall provision**. Our Primary PE Subject Leaders Award (*accredited*) will provide a perfect programme for your **quality of leadership and management** – perfect for accountability.
