The MaST programme is a two-year Masters-level course through which participating teachers extend their knowledge, skills and understanding of mathematics and related pedagogy, and develop the skills to support other colleagues in mathematics.

What are the benefits to the school?

- Gain a deeper understanding of the nature of mathematics within the Early Years Foundation Stage, primary curriculum and Key Stage 3

Who should apply?

Any qualified teacher working within a primary school setting is eligible to apply. They do not necessarily need to be a leading mathematics teacher or a mathematics co-ordinator, but will require the recommendation and support of their head teacher.
