Course context:

The importance of training for staff working with children, young people and their families is receiving increased attention in relation to ensuring personnel receive the best possible training to enhance their roles.

This 3 day core training is compliant with the Common Core of Skills and Knowledge for Children's Workforce staff and is aligned to the Children's Workforce Development Council induction standards; linked to relevant National Occupational Standards.

Audience: Parent Support Advisers, Extended Schools Coordinators, Teaching Assistants with a family support responsibility, Family Support Workers in schools and settings, Pastoral Team Members, Voluntary sector organisation, Family Workers and those involved in delivery of family support, family learning and transitions support.

The module themes consist of:

Module 1 - Principles, values and legislation

Module 2 - Understanding children & young people's development

Module 3 - Building relationships and communicating with children, young people and families

Module 4 - Keeping children and young people safe from harm

Module 5 - Integrated working

Training enables optional accreditation: Supporting Teaching and Learning; Level 3 Certificate in Work with Parents (City and Guilds). Accreditation is arranged through Adult Education.
