What does it mean for Christians to welcome the stranger?

A brand new programme to meet your RE KS2 needs



Devised by Kathryn Wright, RE Advisor, and Juliet Corbett, Schools Officer, this programme is now one of the KS2 exemplars used in the 2012 Norfolk Agreed Syllabus.

About the programme

Children will have the opportunity to engage, enquire, explore, evaluate and express as they investigate the concept of hospitality in Norwich Cathedral during its past life as a monastery and its present life as the mother church of the Diocese.

This programme offers a variety of ways to investigate the concept through Bible stories about Jesus, role play, questioning of Cathedral staff, creating a welcome banner and reflecting on concepts of cultural diversity, kindness and stranger issues.

How much does it cost?

 \pounds 120 per 30 children (\pounds 4 per child), maximum of 60 KS2 pupils. Adults and helpers, free.
