

WOULD YOU LIKE QTS BUT DON'T NEED A TRAINING COURSE?

ASSESSMENT ONLY ROUTE to QTS

The Assessment Only Route is designed for instructors teaching in school who wish to gain Qualified Teacher Status without undertaking a training programme.

Places still available

Once accepted onto the programme, you can gain your qualification through SNITT [Suffolk and Norfolk Initial Teacher Training] in 12 weeks while still carrying out your normal job.

Applicants must:

- have been teaching successfully for at least two years full-time or the equivalent
- be in a school which will fully support you through the application and assessment process
- have taught in two schools (otherwise you must complete a short second school placement)
- be a graduate with a good honours degree
- hold GCSEs in English and Maths at Grade C or above or equivalent
- also hold GCSE Grade C or above in Science, if teaching children of Primary age.
