Curiouser and curiouser: *free* 'A' level Art Masterclasses at Norwich Castle Museum & Art Gallery

This is a chance for 'A' level students to develop their artistic thinking skills and techniques by working with artist Marjolijn Dijkman to reinterpret the exhibition: *Curiosity: Art and the Pleasures of Knowing*, at the Castle Museum this Autumn.

Dijkman works in diverse media – from photographic archives and films, to landscape interventions and sculptural works. She focusses on space and place as a way of understanding - or not - the world around us. In the masterclass she will be using a variety of media, including quick-dry plaster, to create 'curiosities of the future', and as well as using the exhibition she will inspire students with her huge mobile hanging in the Museum rotunda.

Dijkman lives and works in Brussels and Rotterdam. Recent solo exhibitions have been in Birmingham, London, and Berkeley and; group exhibitions in The Netherlands, Marrakech, Porto Alegre, Barcelona, and Korea. She is a tutor at the Fine Art Department of the MFA AKV St. Joost
