

# FFT briefing with the experts

This briefing is for **primary school Headteachers** and **Chairs of Governors** (or a representative) and will be more applicable for schools with Key Stage 2 pupils, but those with just Key Stage 1 are also welcome.

Two FFT directors will demonstrate a wealth of data available through FFTlive. **Bring your FFT School Self-Evaluation Booklet and Governor Dashboard** for a guided tour. They will visit the student explorer and share an insight into future developments.

## How well do you know your school?

- How well do you understand how the progress of your pupil groups compare to National figures?
- Do you understand how FFT data can support your self-evaluation?
- Are governors ready for the questions Ofsted ask about pupil achievement?
- How much do you know about pupils who join your school? Their SEN and FSM history?

## Are you demonstrating Ambition and Challenge?

- How do you know that pupil targets are sufficiently ambitious and challenging?
- How do you pick out the pupils with the potential to make better than expected progress?
