Are you demonstrating Ambition and Challenge?

- How do you know that pupil targets are sufficiently ambitious and challenging?
- How do you pick out the pupils with the potential to make better than expected progress?

Sir Michael Wilshaw, Ofsted's Chief Inspector, said earlier this year, "there will be 'no excuses' for governors who don't understand and challenge their school robustly".
