

Post 16 data workshop



Review and analyse your Post-16 performance data using five different data sources, and gain an insight into how Ofsted might be using your data to make judgements about the performance of your Sixth Form.

The workshop will support participants with using the different performance analysis datasets available, including the interactive online systems:

- EPAS 2013 (and previous years) – various reports and analyses on attainment and progress by cohort, by subject, by student
- FFTLive 2013 (and previous years) – self-evaluation by subject and by student, and new estimates now available for current Year 12 and 13

And the datasets provided by the DfE and used by Ofsted:

- Level 3 VA 2012 (and 2013 if available)
- QSR (Qualification Success Rates) 2012
- PANDA 2013

The workshop will include the opportunity for networking and sharing thoughts and ideas, and will include a brief discussion on the recent 16-19 accountability consultation.

This workshop is suitable for both colleagues new to Post-16 performance data and those already familiar with it. A senior leader attending with the data manager is most beneficial.
