

SMSC in action for secondary schools



Identifying and developing clear and measurable SMSC teaching and learning in the school curriculum is a key requirement for a successful Ofsted Inspection.

This course will support schools in identifying the existing practices and developing other opportunities in all areas of the curriculum.

Delegates will engage in professional dialogue to ascertain accurate understanding of what SMSC is and 'looks like'. Tools to identify, plan for and highlight SMSC in 'pupil speak' to support colleagues across the school will be tabled, trialled and discussed enabling delegates to consider adapting them for their own context.

Measuring tools will be explored and ways of converting soft data to hard data will be considered.
