Teaching and Learning

Improving Maths Programme



A 3-day programme for primary teachers to improve standards of mathematics by addressing teaching and learning in the classroom.

Delegates will attend a three-day programme aimed at improving their skills, mathematical subject knowledge and pedagogy. The programme will focus on planning, assessment and teaching strategies for the whole curriculum, based on research, case studies and Ofsted criteria. Delegates will be given access to relevant resources to support their development and reflection.

Particularly useful for NQTs, returners to teaching, non-specialists and teachers who need their skills refreshing.

Course objectives

- Gain a deep understanding of the nature of mathematics
- Develop the knowledge and confidence in subject knowledge to teach all areas of the curriculum
- Understand the methods of supporting/teaching calculations
- Promote effective teaching and learning in the maths classroom.

The programme works best if schools are able to send teachers out in pairs, to better support application back in school including the - specific school-based gap tasks. However, it is still viable if a school cannot release teachers at the same time, as it is possible to create a triad across different schools, or nominate a learning partner back in school.
