

Teaching and Learning

Improving English Programme



A 3-day programme for primary teachers to improve their practice in the teaching of English. A chance to get together and develop skills with a clear school improvement focus in mind.

Each session has a particular teaching and learning focus and is designed to allow participants to improve their own classroom practice.

Course objectives

- Explore the principles behind effective planning and assessment – including the teaching sequence for writing, differentiation and ensuring challenge.
- Look at key teaching strategies such as shared and guided reading and writing and talk for writing
- Consider the selection of resources, such as quality texts, to engage and enthuse
- Explore making accurate assessments and using information to inform teaching and set high expectations.

The programme works best if schools are able to send teachers out in pairs or threes, to better support application back in school - including the specific school-based gap tasks. However, it is still viable if a school cannot release teachers at the same time, as it is possible to create a triad across different schools, or nominate a learning partner back in school.
