A 3-day programme for teachers to improve their practice in teaching in the EYFS.

This programme will improve knowledge, skills and pedagogy of those seeking to develop their existing EYFS practice in planning, assessment and teaching.

Delegates will have access to an on-line space through which they can access relevant resources, reflect on their practice and network with colleagues.

Course objectives

- Develop and deepen understanding of key aspects of good teaching and learning in the EYFS and the subject knowledge which underpins this
- Influence classroom practice, through exposure to practical ideas to challenge and engage pupils.

The programme works best if schools are able to send teachers out in pairs, to better support application back in school – including the specific school-based gap tasks. However, it is still viable if a school cannot release teachers at the same time, as it is possible to create a triad across different schools, or nominate a learning partner back in school.
