Grammatical features EAL pupils find challenging (Secondary)

How to help students with English as an additional language (EAL) overcome the tricky features of English grammar.

English has many grammatical features which present speakers of other languages with considerable difficulties. This three half-day programme will explore these difficult features and discuss how to help EAL students overcome them. Delegates will explore how they can supplement the planning for teaching of text, sentence and word level at lower and upper KS2 to support their EAL pupils. They will be provided with an EAL scheme of work for young people new to English and more advanced learners.

- Understand the difficulties presented by English grammar to EAL students
- Consider a number of approaches to helping EAL students overcome the barriers to learning and communication presented by English grammar
- Plan lessons and schemes of work that incorporate best practice in EAL provision.



