Entries should be no larger than A3 size. Pictures may be in any medium, i.e. watercolour, oils, pastels, poster paints, powder colours, acrylics, crayons, pen and ink, pencil, and textiles although heavy collages are not always suitable for display, (No photography please). There is no limit to the number of entries per school. The winning entries will be on display in the Schools Marquee at the Royal Norfolk Show on 25 & 26 June 2014, Prize giving will take place in the marquee on Thursday 26 June. Certificates will be sent to Highly Commended work.

Closing Date for entries - Friday 11th April 2014

The competition is open to Norfolk, Suffolk & Cambridgeshire Schools. Judging will take place week commencing 21st April.
