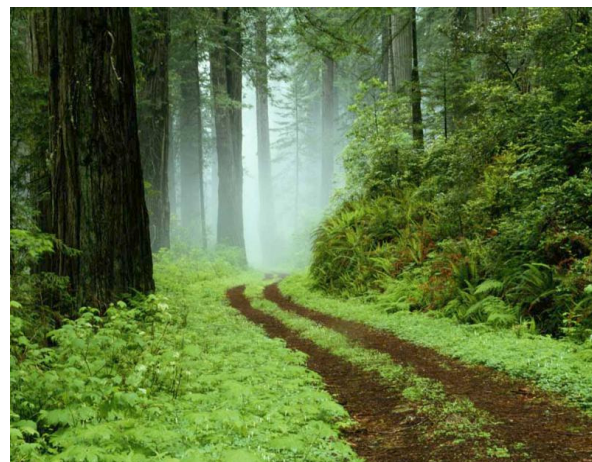

Risk Management of Trees for Outdoor Learning & Site Management (level 1 inspection course)



This course is suitable for those using their grounds for learning, those responsible for maintaining school grounds/ wooded spaces, Forest School Leaders, Caretakers/Site Managers.

Schools must have a system in place to monitor trees in order to comply with the Norfolk County Council Tree Safety Management Policy. To do this they must either undertake this course or pay NORSE to undertake a survey and then write a management plan for them.



Tree Legal Ltd devised this course and are an approved provider with LANTRA (the industry lead body). Participants will be led through a practical day of learning where real case study trees in the Holt Hall grounds are examined. They will have plenty of time to ask questions. The day has been devised to include integrated assessment, so there will be a short set of questions at the end of the day. After the day, Tree legal Ltd will award either certificates of attendance or competence (which state on the reverse information related to what was covered and the test taken, and will provide a report indicating any weak areas for each trainee).

Important information for delegates:

- much of the day will take place outdoors so please bring suitable outdoor wear (warm layers, long trousers, full waterproofs, walking boots or similar, and if it's a hot day, suncream and a water bottle)
- please bring a packed lunch with you
