Outdoor and Environmental Learning Activities Using the School Grounds and Local Environment

Norfolk Integrated Education Advisory Services

Audience: All Primary teachers, leaders and others involved in leading groups on educational and off-site visits.

Context: It shares some of the activities in the Outdoor Education Advisers' newly published Environmental Learning Cards and also provides each delegate with a set to take back to school with them (retail price £50) included in the cost of the training. The cards provide participants with a series of easy to follow environmental activities that can be undertaken on or close to the school grounds. Each of the 26 activities stand alone in their own right, or can be further adapted and extended to suit specific needs and learning outcomes. There is guidance in each card in support of this.

They are divided into four areas of learning:

- Create and Share
- Awareness and experience
- Explore and understand
- Sustain and conserve

The Cards are supported by a Handbook and CD (provided in the cost of the course) that provide detailed information on all aspects of activity delivery. All key elements for successful delivery are explored further in the training course.

By the end of the course participants will:

- Have undertaken a range of activities suitable for use with the Primary Phase
- Have increased confidence to lead an outdoor lesson with their pupils
- Have access to a total of 26 ideas for outdoor lessons in a format that can be shared with other staff
