

Dear All,

Suffolk & Norfolk Initial Teacher Training still has some training places remaining for September 2014 for:

- Mathematics
- Physics
- Chemistry
- MFL
- Computing
- Geography
- Biology

Two options are available: the non-salaried route (Secondary SCITT and School Direct) and the salaried route (School Direct Salaried) with both offering a Postgraduate Certificate in Education with 60 Masters level credits in addition to Qualified Teacher Status.

If we are to maintain a steady stream of new teachers into these subjects in our schools, local teacher training plays a vital part in achieving this as statistics show that the vast majority who train with us become NQTs in Norfolk and Suffolk.

Partnership schools have been very successful in the past in identifying individuals who have the potential to be teachers.
