



Free Diabetes training for schools

This new training course will be delivered at no cost to schools through a partnership between Paediatric Diabetes Outreach Nurses from the 3 Norfolk Hospitals (The Jenny Lind Children's Hospital at the Norfolk & Norwich University Hospital, The Queen Elizabeth Hospital and The James Paget Hospital) and the Healthy Schools Team in Norfolk.

By attending the training participants will have an understanding of this medical condition and its impact on children and young people in schools. Participants will be provided with supporting information to cascade to colleagues back in school. Many schools will already have pupils with a diagnosis of diabetes and all schools may find pupils with diabetes will come through the school system to their school at some point.

By attending this training participants will have:

- Up to date information about Diabetes and how best children can manage the condition in school
- An understanding of how Diabetes is treated and managed and the implications for individual school management and policy
- An opportunity to explore issues of inclusion and equality
- Increased knowledge of how individual care plans are developed and the role of the school in managing these
- An opportunity to share good practice and problem-solve with colleagues from schools and Diabetic Nurse Specialists
