## "Chelsea's Choice" Drama Production on Child Sexual Exploitation FREE FOR ALL NORFOLK SECONDARY SCHOOLS

I would very much like to invite you to take advantage of an interactive drama presentation to be delivered within your school aimed at Year 9 pupils.

Chelsea's Choice is a theatre production by a company called AlterEgo. The play is aimed at raising awareness amongst young people, in Year 9, about CSE and tells the story of a group of three students who discover the diary of a girl called Chelsea. The production is acted by young actors and takes about 30 minutes followed by an hour's discussion. The play has been well received by schools in Lincolnshire, Gloucestershire, Leicestershire, Peterborough and more recently in Cambridgeshire.

As part of the continued programme of awareness about CSE, Norfolk Safeguarding Children Board have agreed to fund the full cost of Chelsea's Choice being delivered in all Norfolk High Schools during Nov/Dec.

Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) is an identified priority for schools and you will be aware featured prominently in the recently published DFE safeguarding guidance. Chelsea's Choice provides a superb opportunity for schools to demonstrate their commitment to tackling CSE and to provide high quality input for students.
