

To End All Wars

Norwich Theatre Royal in partnership with the Heritage Lottery Fund and Norfolk County Council have created an opportunity for pupils in schools across Norfolk to step back in time and learn about day-to-day life during the First World War as part of a major centenary educational programme.

The classroom learning programme reveals the stories of 'ordinary' people who lived in Norfolk during the Great War.

A special website has been created— see www.toendallwars.co.uk — and can be used by teachers and as a place where schools can upload and share some of the work they have completed.

Pupils across Norfolk schools have been busy working on the first stage of the learning programme designed for Key Stage 1-4. It includes looking at case studies, historical materials, questions and activities, and a toolkit to help schools develop their own approaches to the study of World War 1
