County Swimming Certificate – Supporting the learning poolside (mandatory)



orfolk Integrated Education Advisory Services (NIEAS)

This course is a County requirement for all primary phase teachers, Teaching Assistants and school staff who are working alongside the fully qualified swimming teacher / instructor and who will be teaching a small group of pupils in shallow water.

It allows staff to operate in shallow water (less than 1.0 m) with a group of no more than 10 pupils of a similar ability, under the supervision of a qualified swimming teacher / instructor. This course is well resourced and all candidates receive a CD or, if organised as a cluster event, the school receives all the resources to disseminate.

Important information: This course is both practical and theoretical. A component of the course requires a session (approximately 1 hour) in the pool (shallow end). Time in the pool is not a test of candidates' abilities but a chance for them to: experience and explore what the tasks feel like; how the swimmer's body moves; to use the resources, floats, woggles etc. The rest of the course will be in the classroom.
