Raising achievement through outdoor learning



This course is suitable for teachers, Learning Support Assistants, freelancers, outdoor learning officers and headteachers.

This course introduces teachers to a range of activities that can be undertaken in the outdoor classroom linked to several curriculum areas and to problem solving. The day takes the form of three practical outdoor workshops (themed on literacy, numeracy and science) where participants have a chance to participate in a variety of activities that can be used, and adapted for use, with primary phase children.

By the end of the course participants will have:

- gained a number of ideas for activities to do with children that inspire them to develop their mathematical, literacy and scientific skills in the outdoors
- undertaken various activities that support problem-solving and teamwork
- gained the confidence to undertake an outdoor lesson with their pupils
- understand where to go to locate existing good practice, resources and further support.
