Supporting learning poolside: County Swimming Certificate



orfolk Integrated Education Advisory Services (NIEAS) This course allows school staff to work with a small group of pupils (not exceeding ten) of similar ability in shallow water (not exceeding 1m) under the direction of the Swimming Instructor.

This course increases the effectiveness of PE provision, by enhancing teaching and learning in swimming. Possibly using the PE Premium, it enables schools to decrease group size and provide targeted support for individuals or groups of pupils and can help increase the overall percentage of pupils able to swim 25m by the end of key stage 2.

Delegates will enter the water in a local primary school pool. This will allow the practical application of knowledge, the understanding of teaching points and effective technique. It will also allow them to review their own swimming technique and style.

Important information: This course is both practical and theoretical. A component of the course requires a session (approximately 1 hour) in the pool (shallow end). Time in the pool is not a test of candidates' abilities but a chance for them to: experience and explore what the tasks feel like; how the swimmer's body moves; to use the resources, floats, woggles etc. The rest of the course will be in the classroom.
