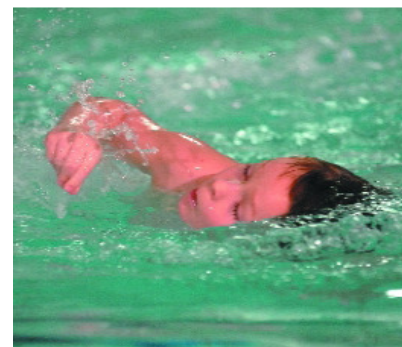


The safe supervision of curricular swimming lessons



This course is to support headteachers who wish to deploy anyone other than a teacher with QTS to act as Visit Leader when facilitating and planning swimming provision.

It ensures that staff understand their roles and responsibilities and are supported in this deployment. Delegates will be able to assess the quality of the existing provision and, through discussions with the school's EVC, will ensure best practice compliance with national and local guidelines.

This course can be delivered in schools to support larger numbers of TAs as required or as part of a cluster training offer. The course does not require entry into water as it is entirely theoretical.

This course will provide:

- Engagement in active discussion and reflection upon the best practice in effective supervision of swimming, based on national and local guidance
- Evaluate existing provision against these guidelines to plan actions required
- Ensure clear understanding of roles and responsibilities – especially in relation to Over Watch and Visit Leader status.
