The Dyslexia Outreach Service

The Dyslexia Outreach Service (part of the Learning and Cognition Specialist Resource Base programme) is now centrally based and hosted by Taverham High School, which also has teachers based at Mile Cross Primary School and Aylsham High School. The aims of the dyslexia SRB are to provide outreach advice and support, training and development to mainstream schools and clusters on whole school approaches, curriculum differentiation, support strategies and best practice in supporting children with a wide range of specific learning difficulties including dyslexia, dysgraphia and dyscalculia.
