Step On Training

Step On training provides a foundation knowledge in understanding and responding to behaviour within settings. The course explores a therapeutic model for understanding and responding to both pro social and anti social behaviours.

In addition, the course will explore law and guidance relevant to physical intervention within settings and provide advice on the safe and effective use of everyday physical interventions.

This training is primarily aimed at new staff joining services already committed to the Norfolk Steps approach.

This course contains physical elements so therefore delegates must realistically consider their own physical ability and ensure suitable clothing is worn.
