Delegates will be encouraged to look at their data and also to think about the experience of EAL children and parents. They will reflect on policies and practice in their schools and consider how to narrow the attainment gap for pupils.

Delegates will look at effective action planning and how the Minorities Achievement and Attainment Services (MAAS) can help support their improvement plans.

Good provision for EAL learners is good provision for all learners. Focussing on these key areas will help whole-school improvement. To facilitate and embed the reflective and sustainable practice schools need, each school may bring two candidates to the training for the single learner course fee. This is due in part to the funding received by MAAS.
