Early exposure to foreign languages will build stronger multi-tasking skills, improve memory and decision-making, perceptiveness and English grammar and sentence structure. Children who study foreign languages tend to score better on standardised tests than their monolingual peers, particularly in mathematics, reading and vocabulary.

- have been introduced to fundamentals such as greetings, classroom instructions, colours, parts of the body, family, numbers and animals
- have access to a variety of Spanish resources (videos, songs, rhymes) for classroom use and have the possibility of twinning up with a Spanish school.
