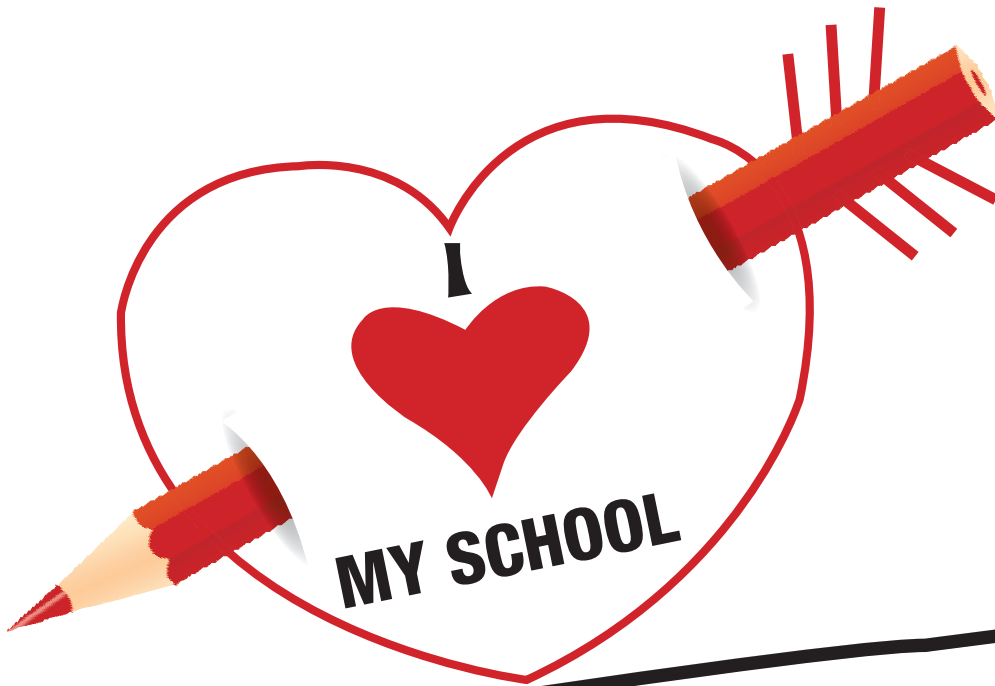

• **Contribution to the Community**

Presented to an individual, class or school for a service that benefits the community. Judges will look for any activities, programmes and initiatives that demonstrate a real commitment to their local neighbourhood.

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• **Environmental**

Presented to an individual, class or school that has demonstrated a commitment to improving its carbon footprint. If you, your class or school have introduced positive changes that really make a difference to the quality of life in your school or community, then you should enter the awards. Your project needs to demonstrate a positive contribution to the environment through, for example, caring for the natural environment, improving use of resources, reducing pollution or increasing environmental understanding.

• **Head Teacher Of The Year (Primary)**

This award will go to an inspirational Primary School Headteacher who has shown exceptional management and teaching skills and commitment to their school.

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• **Head Teacher Of The Year (Secondary)**

This award will go to an inspirational Secondary School headteacher or principal who has shown exceptional management and teaching skills and commitment to their school, academy or college.

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• **Inspirational Teacher Of The Year (Primary)**

This award recognises outstanding school teachers who inspire in their students a love of learning, who encourage them to pursue excellence, and gives them the skills and enthusiasm they need to make a positive difference in the world.

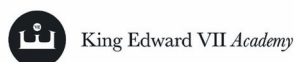
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• **Inspirational Teacher Of The Year (Secondary)**
