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Visit Leader Training – Part A (Theory)

What is it about?

It is a Outdoor Education Advisers Panel certificated course transferable between employers.

The course covers the identification of relevant significant hazards and the importance of placing of successful control measures including supervision and group management strategies

The course is offered in support of the leader's role in educational visits and off-site activities. It remains the role of the employer (e.g. head of establishment, senior youth worker or Educational Visit Co-ordinator) to determine the leader's suitability and competence to undertake a leadership role on any particular visit or venture.

What will I get out of it?

- This is a Nationally recognised & certified course.
- It covers how to plan safe visits that comply with National & Local guidance, including how to use Evolve to plan visits.
- This Theory Part A course can be delivered locally in schools or clusters to reduce costs & travel & can be day time or after school. Cost of half day/twilight session is £350 LA maintained schools and all other clients.
- It is advised that this is then consolidated with the Part B Practical course wherever possible.
- This course will raise confidence & competence that should support commitment in leading effective & safe visits.
